



Lledr Hall Residential: **Frequently Asked Questions**



Where is Lledr Hall?

Lledr Hall is in Wales, situated near a small village called Dolwyddelan.

What is Lledr Hall?

Lledr Hall is a Salford Council activity centre that provides outdoor activities for Salford children.

Is it a secure building?

During the day the centre is staffed by Lledr Hall staff, during the evenings the centre is managed by school staff and is securely locked. A member of school staff is available through the night and children will be made aware of the procedures. A member of Lledr Hall staff lives locally and is on call.

Who takes the children?

Three members of school staff attend Lledr Hall allowing three activity groups each day with school and centre staff. Mr Bloodworth is the lead for the trip alongside two other members of staff.

Can children take mobile phones?

No, Lledr Hall is situated in the mountains and therefore no mobile phone reception is available.

Do all the staff at Lledr Hall have a DBS check?

All council staff undergo the same procedures and checks as school staff and have valid DBS checks.

Will there be a first aider on every activity/on site at all times?

Activity leaders are first aid trained. School staff are also available and trained for during the evenings.

My child is a fussy eater, will he/she cope?

Each meal comes as two parts, for example breakfast has cereals and a cooked breakfast to ensure everyone will eat something. Although the meals are set parents can advise of any special dietary requirements before the trip and Lledr Hall will, where possible, provide an alternative.

My child has never been away from home, will he/she cope?

Every child copes differently away from home, however, the majority get through the week without a hint of home sickness and many thrive in ways we wouldn't have expected. We have only ever had positive feedback from children once they have returned.

My child is on medication, can he/she still go?

Yes. Medication must be given to staff before they leave.

Do I need to buy any equipment?

No. Specialist equipment is provided by Lledr Hall. All you will need is a sleeping bag and clothes.

Will we receive contact from you?

We will update the school blog each night with photos and an update, the children will not be able to ring home and you will only get a phone call from us if needed.

What are the sleeping arrangements?

The centre is split into two sides for boys and girls. The staff room is situated in the middle. The children will be in dorms with groups of children in bunk beds.
